Vocabulary	Student consistently uses extensive vocabulary. Vocabulary is appropriate and accurate. Response consistently demonstrates awareness of audience. Expression of Ideas/ Elaboration	Superior completion of task; content is appropriate, and well-organized. Elaborates consistently with appropriate and precise details in a coherent manner. Clarity/Fluency	The writing is clear and smooth. It is comprehensible, well-organized, and follows a logical structure.	The writing is usually clear and smooth.
