Applicants will be notified ASAP and will receive further information and instructions at that time. **Pre-Registration and full payment deadline for non-travel programs: May 15, 2010.** Registrations received after May 15, 2010 will be accepted only if space is available and will incur an additional \$25 processing fee. Payment deadlines for study tours vary according to the program. Please contact the appropriate PIER Director for specific deadlines.
